EXAMINATIONS LEADING TO THE DEGREE OF BACHELOR OF ARTS (B.A.) (SIX SEMESTER DEGREE COURSE) BASED ON CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM IN THE FACULTY OF HUMANITIES ORDINANCE, 2017.

Whereas, it is expedient to provide an ordinance in respect of Examinations leading to the degree of Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) (Six Semester Degree Course) based on Choice Based Credit System in the faculty of Humanities, for the purposes hereinafter appearing, the Management Council is hereby pleased to make the following Ordinance:-

- This Ordinance shall be called "Examinations leading to the degree of Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) (Six Semester Degree Course) based on Choice Based Credit System in the faculty of Humanities, Ordinance, 2017."
- 2. This Ordinance shall come into force with effect from the date of its making by the Management Council.
- 3.In this ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires:-
 - 1) "Program" means core/traditional undergraduate degree offered under the faculty discipline of Humanities in the University.
 - 2) "Choice based credit system(CBCS)" means pattern of education system designed to provide choice for students to select courses of their interest from the prescribed Program.
 - 3) "Semester" means an academic year comprising 180 working days in the least is divided into two equal period of study i.e. semesters, each semester having at least 90 working days. With six working days in a week. This would mean that each semester will have 15 teaching/working weeks. The odd semester is scheduled from June/July to November/December and the even semester from November/December to April/May. Each week has a minimum 30 working hours spread over 6 days.
 - 4) "Course" is a structured set of instructions that are imparted to a student on the basis of a syllabus or a framework decided beforehand and has the sanction of the different academic and executive bodies of the University extended over a semester.
 - a) Each course is designed variously under instructions given as Lectures, Tutorials, and Practical (laboratory and field exercises). Usually these components are referred to as L,T, and P components (L T P). The credits for each course

TYPES OF COURSES

- 3. Types of Courses: Courses in a Program may be of three kinds: Core, Elective & Foundation.
- 1) Core course: This is the course which is to be studied compulsorily by a student as a core requirement of a Program in a said discipline of study.
- 2) Elective Courses:

Elective course is a course which is to be chosen from a pool of papers, it may be

- Supportive to the discipline of study.
- Providing an expanded scope.
- Enabling learner to get an exposure to some other discipline / domain
- Nurturing students' proficiency /skill.

An Elective may be generic elective, focusing on those courses, which add generic proficiency. An
