#### **4) Report of the One day National Seminar on “Quality Enhancement for Colleges in Rural Areas: Challenges, Problems and Solutions Under RAF of NAAC”.**

One day National Seminar was organised by the Govindrao Warjekar Arts and Commerce College in Collaboration with NAAC. On the occasion, research papers on various subthemes of the NAAC were invited. A Total 76 research papers were received which were compiled and published in the UGC Care listed Journal “Studies in Indian Places” (Volume 40, Issue No. 31) with impact factor 6.3. **89** delegates from Colleges affiliated to Universities in and out of Maharashtra attended the seminar. The Seminar was inaugurated at the hands of **Shri R.G.Warjekar** President, Janhit Shikshan Sanstha, Brahmapuri. **Dr.W.R.Bhandarkar**, Secretary, Janhit Shikshan Sanstha, Brahmapuri chaired the inaugural ceremony. Principal, **Dr. Sanjay Singh** welcomed the gathering. On the occasion of the seminar the Principals and IQAC coordinators of five constituent college of the Gondwana University Gadchiroli who obtained B++ and above Grades from NAAC were felicitated. **Dr.Devender Kawday**, Deputy Adviser, NAAC, Bangalore delivered the Keynote address. The session was conducted by **Dr. Deepak Morande**.

In the first technical Session **Dr. Dewender Kawday**, Deputy Adviser NAAC, Bengaluru spoke on “**Online A & A Methodology in Revised Accreditation Framework**”. In the session **Dr. Devender Kawday**, introduced

the participants about the new Revised Accreditation Framework (RAF) – Process of Assessment and Accreditation such as Quantitative Metrics, Qualitative Metrics, Weightage and Benchmarking for various Metrics. He also highlighted the current process followed by NAAC for Logistic arrangement. He enumerated how to sustain quality in all the seven criteria. In his presentation he gave a detailed analysis of the Revised Accreditation Framework updated on January 2020. The resource person insisted on the benefits of Accreditation and the systematic process to sustain quality and how benchmarking should be integrated into the fundamental operations of the Institutions. He enumerated the checklist to be kept while SSR preparation and submission. **Dr. Nikita Mishra** conducted the session.

In the second technical session **Dr. Peeyush Pahade**, Founder Member, IQAC Cluster India & Vice-Principal of H. V. Desai College, Pune, delivered a lecture on “**IQACs in Rural Colleges: Challenges, Problems & Solutions in the RAF of NAAC**”. He explained various aspects of research such as sources of funding, publication, impact factor and citation index, and appealed the delegates to undertake quality research work. While talking on Criterion II Dr. Pahade appealed the administrators of the institutions to provide conducive environment for teaching and learning. He appealed the teacher delegates to adopt innovative teaching methodologies and use ICT extensively to make teaching simple and interesting. It was really an energetic session for the delegates. He also spoke on the need for innovation in curriculum design and listed the open educational e-resources which will enhance ICT learning process. He enumerated various innovative practices that the rural institutions can undertake in all the seven criterions. The session was conducted by **Dr. Rakesh Wasnik**. Each technical session was followed by an interactive session in which the queries of the delegates were clarified by the resource persons.

The Valedictory function was chaired by **Dr. Rajan Jaiswal**, Vice-President, Janhit Shikshan Sanstha, Bramhapuri. **Dr. Shriram Kawale**, Dean, Faculty of Humanities, Gondwana University, Gadchiroli gave the valedictory address. **Dr. Deepak Morande**, **IQAC Coordinator**, proposed vote of thanks. The certificates to the participants were distributed after the valedictory function.
